


Mobile EU citizens represent 40% of our public in 2020



Rough living conditions for 315 mobile EU citizens in Brussels

Among the homeless mobile EU citizens in Brussels, **56% have been in Belgium for more than 5 years**. From these, 55% still do not have a right of residence.

- Since 2003 at DIOGENES; good practice FEANTSA
- Goals: inclusion in the Belgian society + access to rights in Belgium
- Focus at DIOGENES: Roma and Polish mobile EU citizens
- Method : use own culture and language to connect with the people and support them
- Support in all areas of life where they consider they need help
- Awareness rising & deconstruction of stereotypes

Also needed: ad-hoc support

- legal and administrative (e.g. translation)
- it should be long term and intensive
